



## Building Mobile Britain Call To Action

As part of our Building Mobile Britain campaign we are engaging with a range of stakeholders. There are a number of ways national and local decision-makers, as well as industry groups, can support our campaign. Below we have identified just a few.



Local authorities and Local Enterprise Partnerships should ensure mobile infrastructure and deployment are factored into Local Development Plans and Strategic Economic Plans.



Encourage the Chancellor to provide business rates relief in the Autumn Budget to put mobile infrastructure on par with fixed broadband infrastructure.



Request further reform of the planning system to bring more mobile infrastructure into the permitted development rights regime and allow for regular review of planning regulations to ensure flexibility ahead of new technologies.



Respond to the Government's upcoming Building Regulations Review and recommend that building regulations should encourage construction that is sympathetic to mobile coverage.



Ensure your local authority nominates a digital connectivity champion to prioritise mobile and fixed broadband within local government.



Encourage consistency in interpretation of planning regulations across planning authority areas to enable more effective rollout.
